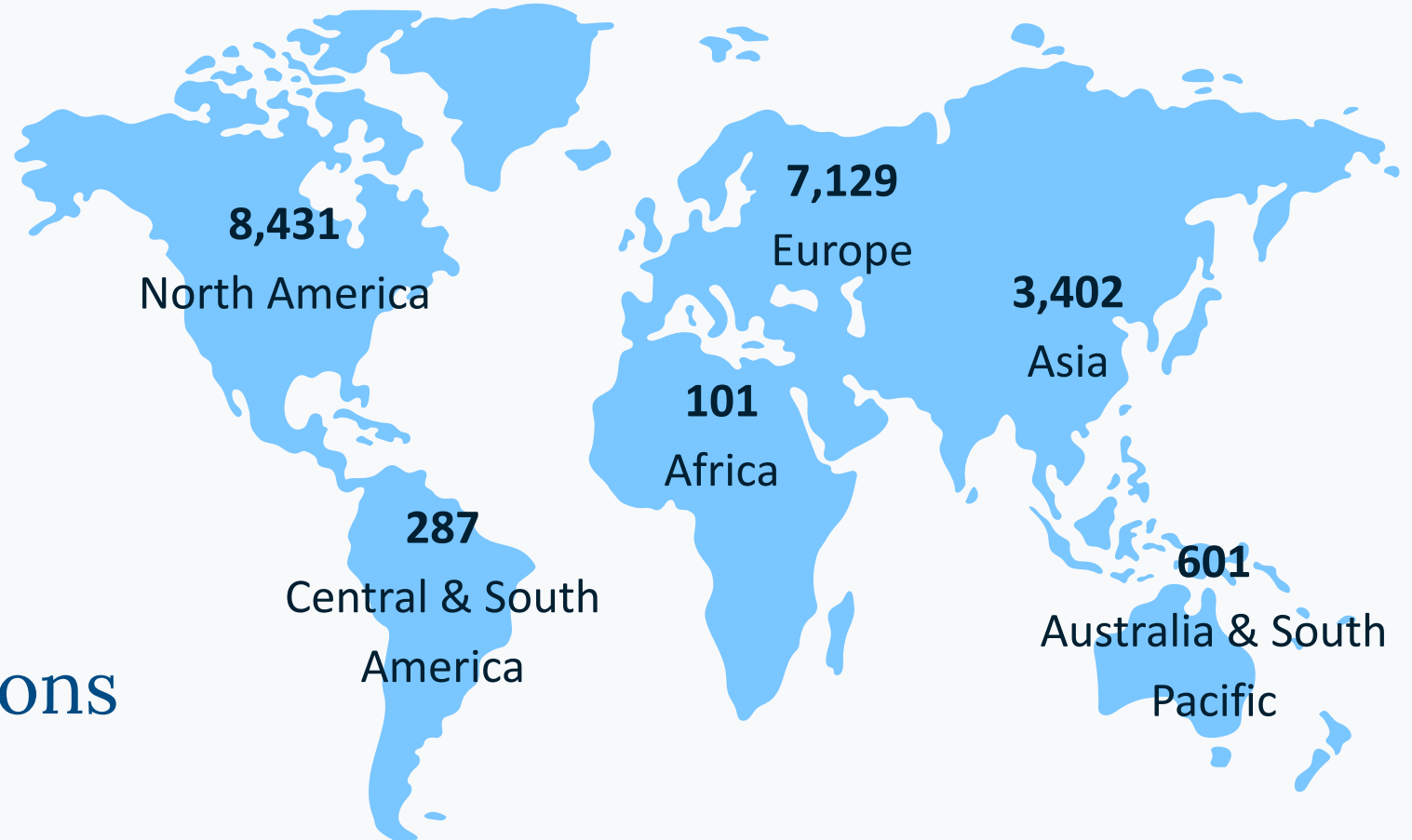

# Advice for First Time Attendees

Don't try to do everything. Do something meaningful.

## 1. Build a Pre-Conference Checklist

- One person I want to meet
- One session I want to learn from
- One idea I want to test with a stranger
- I will talk to one new person by end of day one

## 2. Conversation Starters for meetups, socials, networking events

- What's a session you almost skipped & were glad you did not?
- What's the coolest thing you're working on?
- What was your favorite session so far?
- I don't know anyone here — can I talk to you?

## 3. Following up: Ask, Don't Perform

Find a point of connection with an individual's work.

*One specific comment beats 5 vague comments.*

→ “I appreciated X” lands better than “I loved your work”

## 4. Presenting a Paper:

Prep, practice, time yourself - 2x!

## 5. Choosing Sessions

- The obvious: Related to your research & teaching
- Search by Scholar
- For Curiosity

## 6. Value of community

This is not about schmoozing. → It is about building relationships & your community.

Divisions and Interest Groups (DIGs) help you establish your AOM identity and create a sense of place for those seeking to establish ties with other members

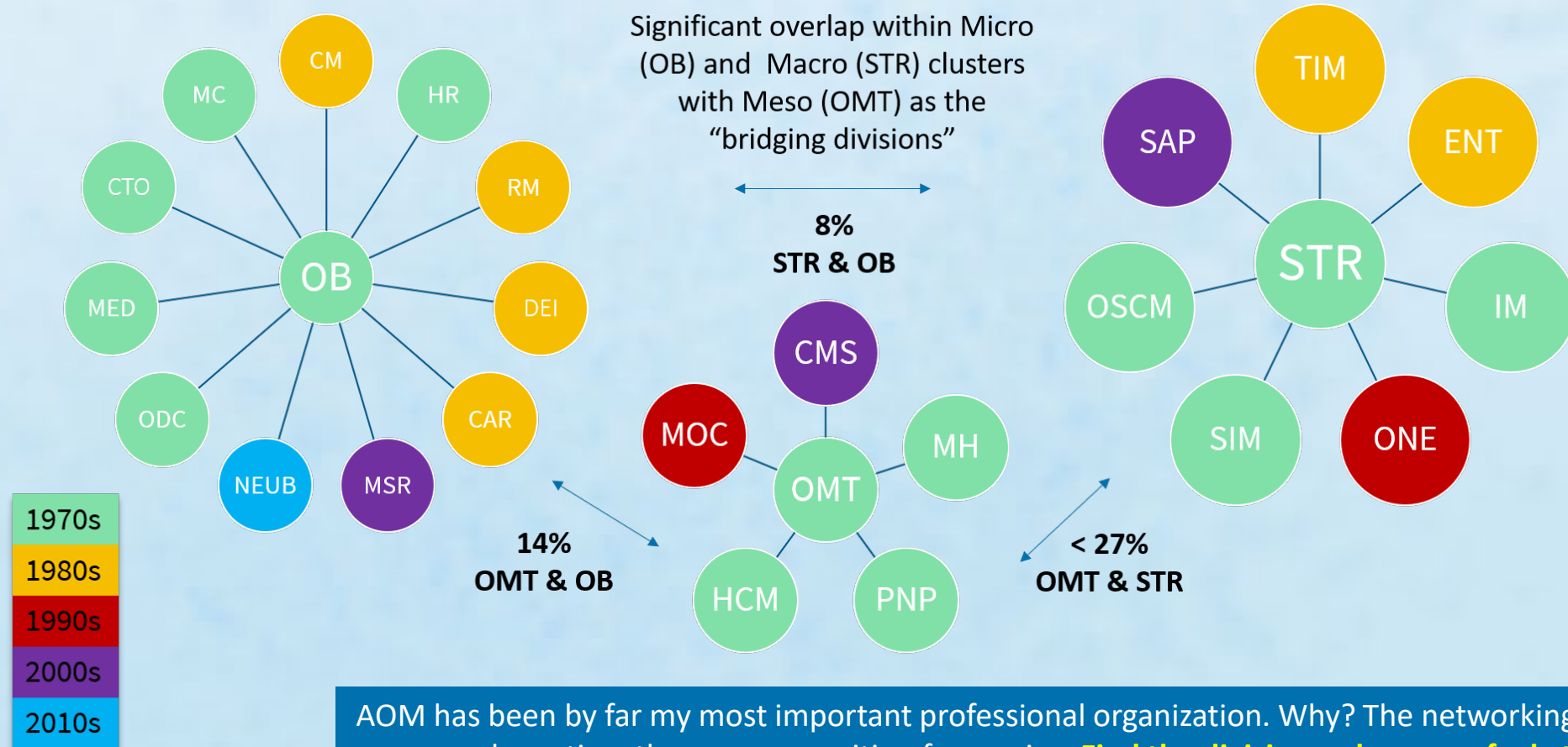

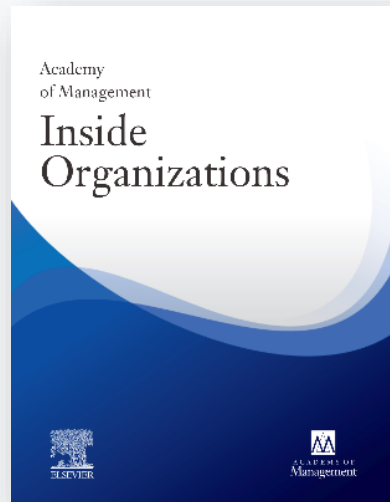
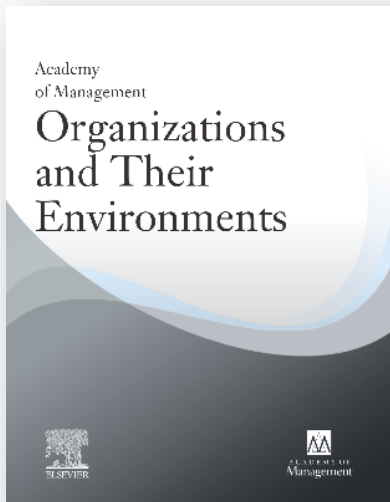




# NEW in 2025: Journal Launches

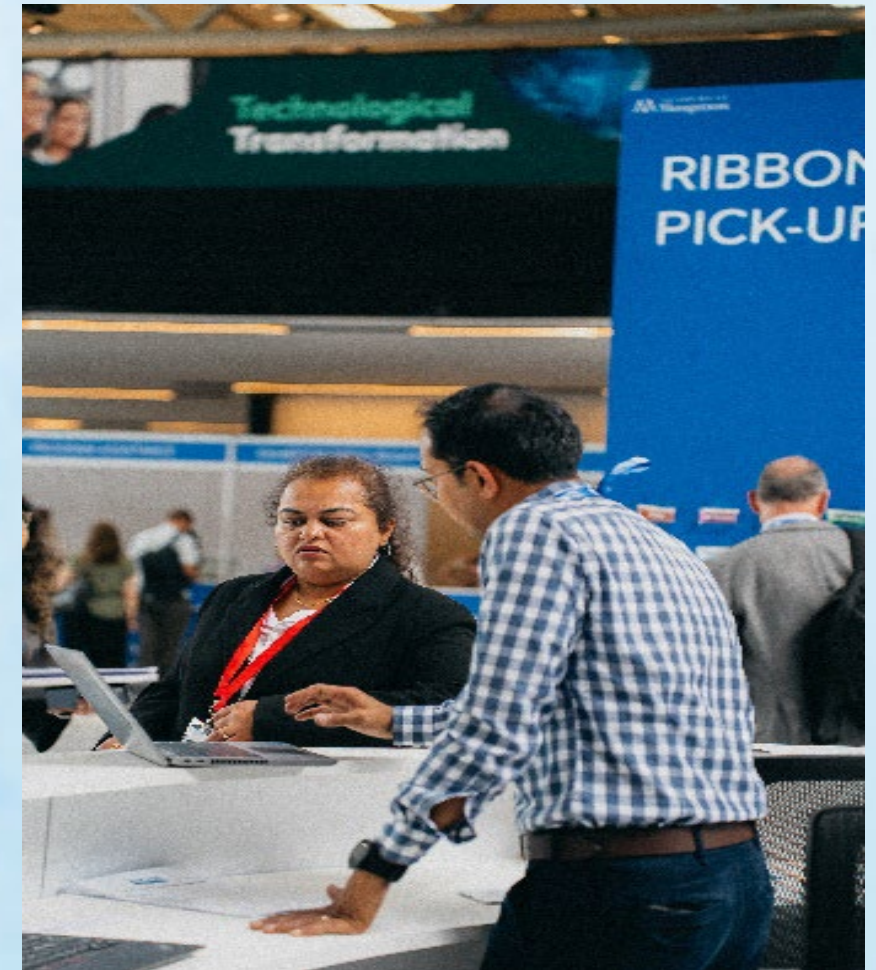

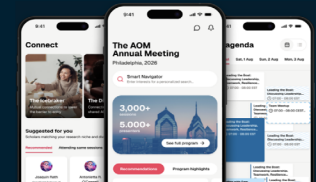

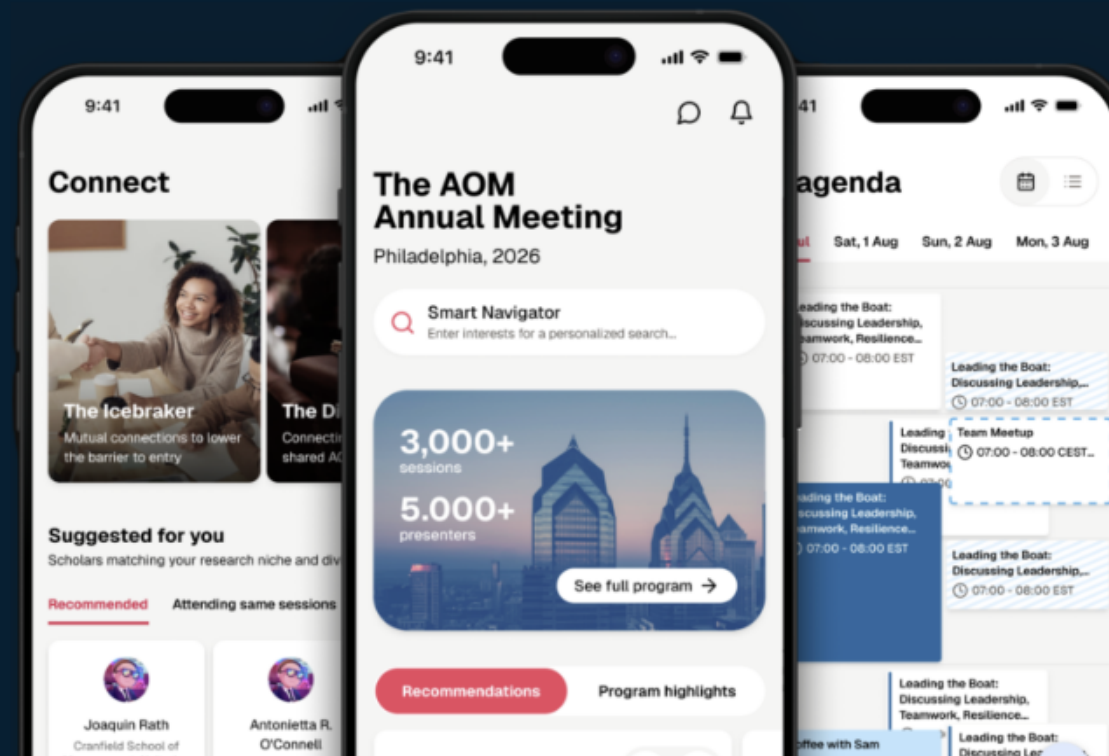
